Garage/Yard Sale – Guidelines during Covid-19 Pandemic

Reopening NY State guidelines must be followed for Phase 4 – See www.forward.NY.gov

Organizers Required Guidelines

- Any garage/yard sale must limit browsers to no more than 50 customers.
- Appropriate face coverings must be used in a situation where you are unable to maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet of another individual. Acceptable face coverings for COVID-19 include, but are not limited to cloth-based face coverings and disposable masks that cover both the mouth and nose.
- Organizers must ensure social distancing of at least 6 feet is maintained among individuals.
- Organizers of the sale should supply hand sanitizer for customers.
- Throughout the day, organizers must regularly clean and disinfect areas where the public might be.
- Tables should be at least 6 feet apart.

City of Glen Cove Charter

Chapter 165. HANDBILLS

§ 165-1 Posting on public property prohibited.

No person shall attach, place, paint, write, stamp, paste or cause to be attached, placed, painted, written, stamped or pasted any sign, advertisement or other matter upon any lamppost, electric light, railway, telephone or telegraph pole, shack, tree or fire hydrant; or upon any bridge, pavement, portion of any sidewalk or crosswalk, public building or any other property or thing belonging to the city, or on any article or thing within any park in the city.
